- 3) Mark 1-7

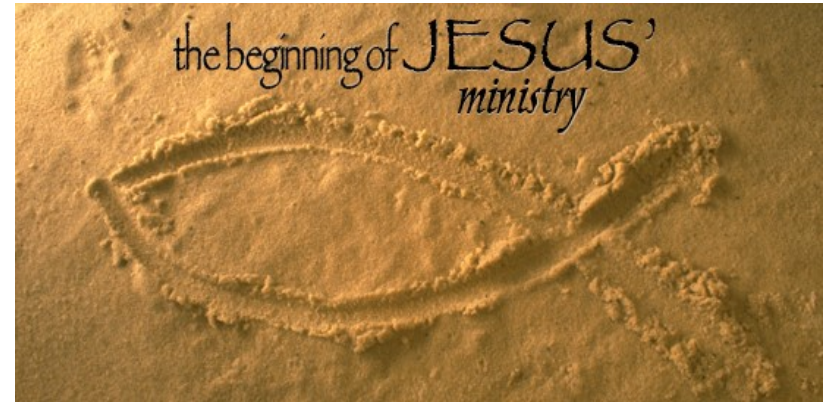
